

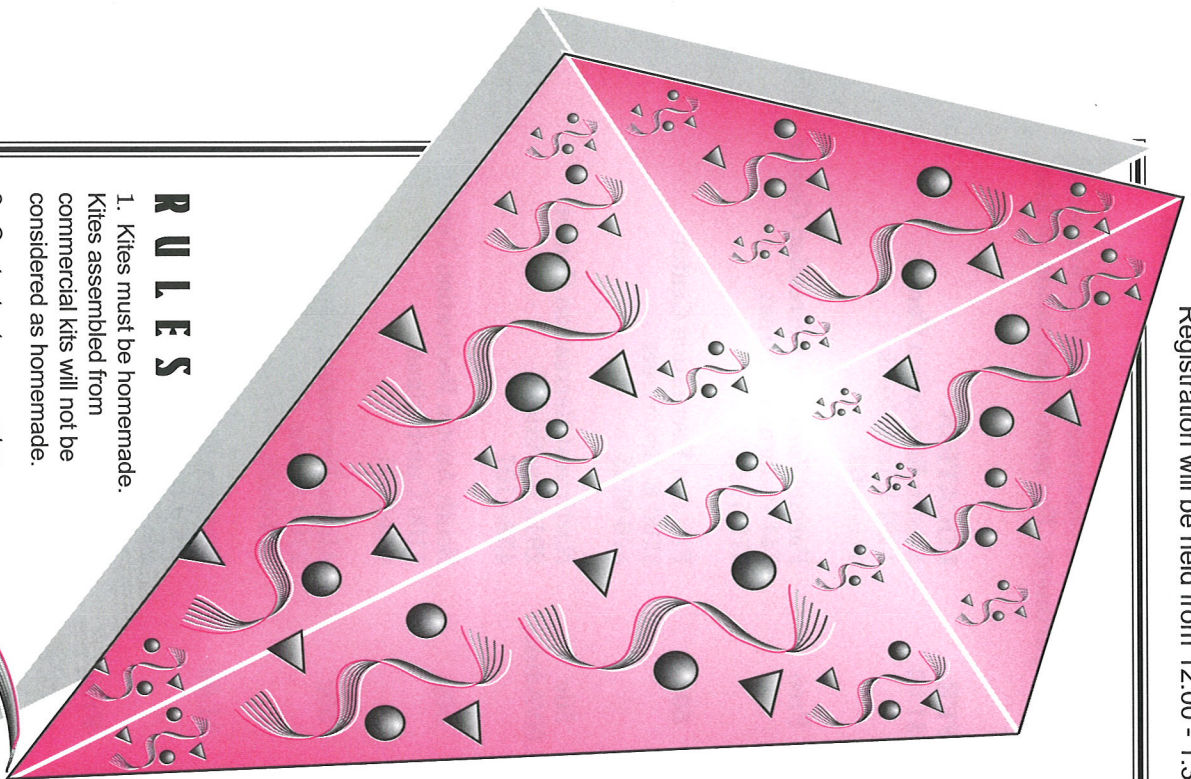

The 69th Annual Zilker Park Kite Festival is open to all ages. Adults may assist children. Contestants must register on-site before the contest and display their numbers at all times. Food & drinks will be available. T-shirts will be for sale.

Registration will be held from 12:00 - 1:30 p.m. on the flying ground. **NO FEE**—Bring the whole family!



RULES

1. Kites must be homemade. Kites assembled from commercial kits will not be considered as homemade.
2. Contestants may enter only one kite per event; they may, however, enter every event, as long as a different kite is entered. (Exception: event Number 1)
3. Kites must fly to qualify for judging.
4. Awards will be given to first, second, and third place winners in each event. Judges' decisions will be final.
5. An award will be presented to the oldest and youngest contestant. The "youngest" must be able to stand unassisted while flying the kite. All entries must fly a kite to be eligible for awards.
6. Contestants must fly kites in designated kite flying area for judging.

EVEN TS

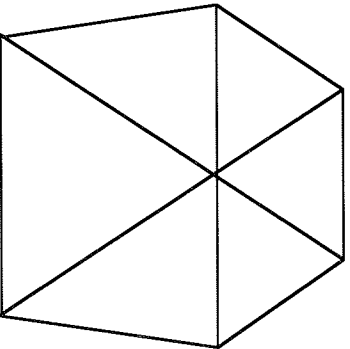
1. 50 Yard Walk: (for children 7-12) Kite must carry at least 50 feet of string and remain airborne during the whole race. Direction of race will be with the wind.
 2. Highest Kite: Contestants will release 200 feet of string and stand on a designated line. The kite flying at the highest angle wins.
 3. Steadiest Kite - youth (15 and under): Kite can either have a tail or not.
 4. Steadiest Kite - adults (16 and up): Kite can either have a tail or not.
 5. Most Creative Kite - youth (15 and under): Youth must have made their own kite. Entries judged on artistic design and beauty.
 6. Most Creative Kite - adults (16 and up): Entries judged on artistic design and beauty.
 7. Strongest Pulling Kite: Each kite's pull will be measured to determine number of pounds. Each kite will be measured a maximum of 2 times. No more than one kite (no trains).
 8. Smallest Kite: Entries must carry at least 25 feet of thread or string and fly higher than point of mooring.
 9. Most Unusual Kite - youth (15 and under): Youth must have made their own kite. Entries will be judged on theme and construction; judges look for odd, striking, and novel features and shapes.
 10. Most Unusual Kite - adults (16 and up): Entries will be judged on theme and construction; judges look for odd, striking, and novel features and shapes.
 11. Largest Kite: Square footage of sail area will determine the largest kite. No trains allowed. Kites must fly at least one minute at the time of judging to qualify. Contestants are limited to three attempts in this event.
- * Please note:** These kites will be subject to a safety inspection before their respective events.

In case of rain, the festival will be rescheduled for Sunday, March 16.

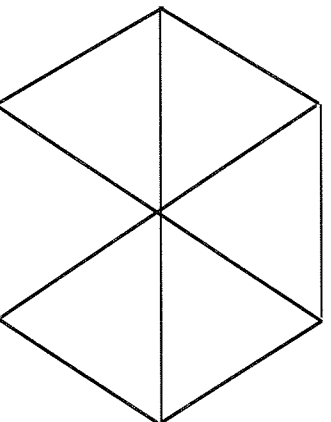

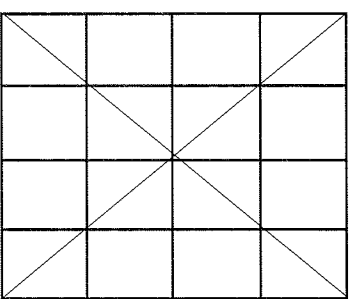

Hexagonal Three Side

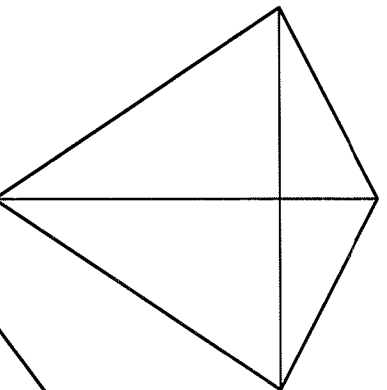

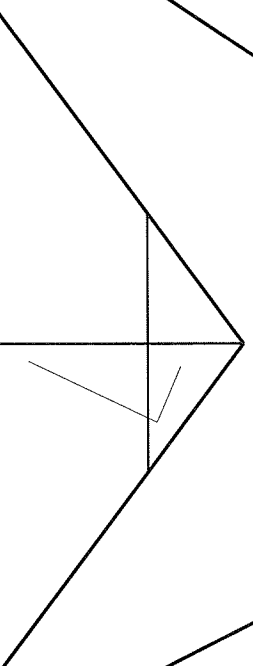

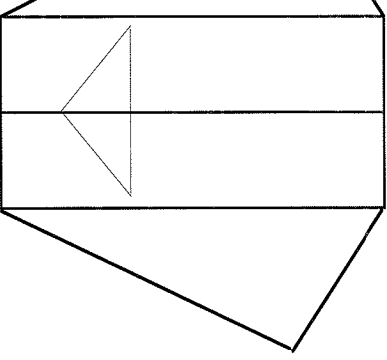
